THE MONTESSORI CLASSROOM

The Montessori classroom is structured in such a way that the child has the ability to move freely without any limitations. The child has the ability to work with all the didactic materials, exploring though his/her senses. The Montessori Directress is there as a guide, to direct and guide the child whenever such is needed. The Directress sets the tasks for the children and the children direct themselves to accomplish the tasks set before them.

"Scientific observation then has established that education is not what the teacher gives; education is a natural process spontaneously carried out by the human individual, and is acquired not by listening to words but by experiences upon the environment." - Maria Montessori, Education for a New World

HeadStart Montessori comprises of two environments, the Toddler environment and the Pre-Primary environment. Our Toddler environment caters for children aged 15 months – $2\frac{1}{2}$ or 3 years, with a ratio of 1:12. The environment has equipment which caters for the needs of the toddler child, which enables the toddler child to move and develop at his/her own ability, thus gaining independence. Our Pre-School environment caters for children from $2\frac{1}{2}$ or 3 years till 6years. In our Pre-School environment there is not grade allocation, however, our children our vertically group between the ages $2\frac{1}{2}$ till 6 years. The ratio is this environment is 1:15.

All our learning areas of prepared and aid the child in the learning process. Everything was been made to be as easily accessible to the children as possible. It is very much their environment rather than then the guides, thus the children are made to feel as comfortable as possible within it.
